

Required Precautions for attending Middle Kingdom meeting and social gatherings

All attendees, including minors, are required to:

1. Sign-in using the [Meeting Attendance Form](#) for SCA and contract tracing purposes.
 - a. This requires printing the first and last name (modern), a valid phone number or email address, and signature. Minors are required to be included on the form with parental signature.
2. Wear masks that cover the nose and mouth at all times. The group is not required to provide masks.
 - a. If an attendee cannot wear a mask due to health conditions, they should not be attending.
 - b. Anyone who is has an underlying condition that may increase risk should not attend an event until the CDC has deemed it appropriate.

3. Social distance – 6 feet apart.
4. Be symptom free. This is a MUST. See link for a list of symptoms defined by the CDC.

5. Use available hand washing facilities, or if not available hand sanitizer.
6. Clean and disinfect surfaces (tables, etc) used before and after the meeting/social gathering using a CDC recommended cleaner and methods:

7. Acknowledge that once maximum capacity for gathering is met, no further attendees are permitted until others leave.
8. No communal food or drink is permitted.
9. Marshal activity is NOT permitted.

If an attendee experiences symptoms up to 14 days after a meeting/social gathering, they MUST contact their local seneschal.

Seneschals will ask any attendee not abiding by these required precautions to leave the meeting/social gathering.
