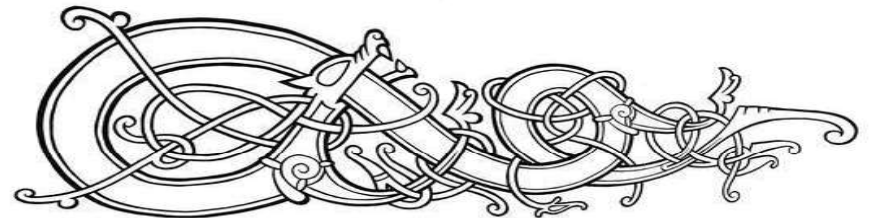
May this season be a time of peace, love, family and good fellowship. Be safe and be kind. And have a Blessed and Happy Holiday!

## GIRDLE BOOKS by Baintighearn Deirdre MakKyneth

Girdle books were smaller tomes with a tail attached to the covering, so they could be worn and hung from the girdle belt.

They were most likely used from 13th-16th centuries, peaking in the 15th and slowly dropping out of favor as a status/financial symbol when use of the printing press became more widely used and available, thus

eliminating the requirement for texts to be hand sewn and written, and therefore, more readily available and cheaper. Girdle books were primarily used by clergy and monks but also by women of nobility as their Book of Hours. There are hundreds of depictions in paintings and sculptures, but only 26 girdle books have been found to date, most likely because of being worn,

they deteriorated more quickly than other books, the oldest datable example being from Kastl, Germany, 1453

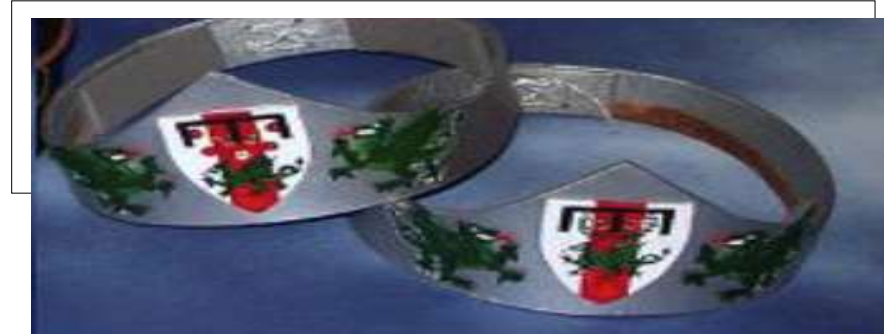
Our next meeting will be December 5th at 2pm. It will be a Zoom meeting.

## Interacting with Important Persons by Mistress Catriona nicHugh Mclaeay

After putting on your best bib and tucker, you only need to remember a few things to survive encounters with important people. 1) There is ALWAYS someone more important than you. 2) You need to recognize this and acknowledge it by a reverence (bow/courtesy) or a bob (quick nod of the head) depending on the circumstances. 3) You do not just go up and start talking to the important people without having an introduction. Look for a retainer or the chamberlain. 4) You can cover over most any awkwardness by being extremely polite.

General rule of thumb, if the crown (Their Royal Majesties) or coronet is gold, the person wearing it is a ruling/landed personage. If the crown (Their Royal Highnesses) or coronet is silver they are heirs, have stepped down from a position, or were created a court baron/baroness by Their Majesties. Usually the headgear has a device or emblem of the territory or personal coat of arms. You can decorate the headpiece any way you wish within the framework of your rank. In other words, check with a reputable herald. For example, a landed baron/baroness has a gold coronet with 6 pearls (round objects). In the Middle Kingdom it has become customary after stepping down from that position, they wear a silver coronet of 12 pearls. How the coronet is decorated is up to the wearer.

For specific information about crowns, coronets, and circlets, and how to interact with those who wear them, check out the Middle Kingdom Pursuivant's Handbook, 2020 edition, pages: 132-134. Go to <https://midrealm.org/> Then, click on Officer Directory, which will show you a menu, click on Office of the Dragon Herald. Scroll down the webpage until you see Heraldic Documents and click on "Herald" folder. This takes you to the library and click on • Handbook – Pursuivant's Handbook, whole. From there you can go to pages 132-134.

There are two other phrases that are important to remember in conjunction with Royalty. The first is the Royal Presence, which is an imaginary circle within 10 feet of the Royal Family. Even if They do not see you, you need to acknowledge Their presence by standing and bowing or curtseying.

The second phrase is Sanctum Mediterraneum with is an imaginary circle 10 feet around the thrones whether They are sitting in them or not. Only Kingdom Officers may enter without permission. You just need to acknowledge Them or Their thrones as you pass by.

In court no live weapons are to be carried into Their presence during the proceedings if and when you are called into Their presence. You need to reverence twice, once at about 10 feet away and second time at about 5 feet away. Talk loud enough that the audience will be able to hear you. When you leave, you should back up and repeat the 2 reverences before turning your back on the royalty.

See....easy peasy. Have fun and enjoy the pomp and circumstances. Ask questions, take in the drama, and remember.... after the event is over, Their Majesties Starbucks coffee costs the same as yours!
